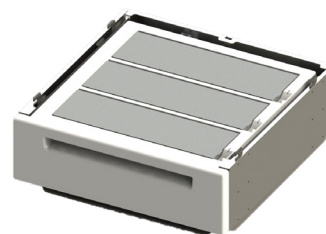

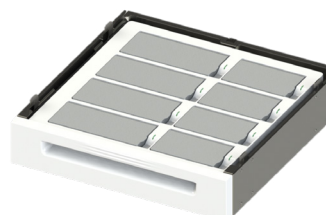
Upright Refrigerator
